THANKS BE TO GOD!

"Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good, for his steadfast love endures forever" (Psalm 136:1).

Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ!

People are quick to celebrate during moments of great success. That's normal and we expect that. But for those in the spotlight it's magnified many times over. Some examples are: those receiving an award such as an Oscar, professional sports teams winning a championship, a politician who wins an election, etc. It's during these celebrations that they are often surrounded by others who share their experience. The difference between our giving thanks to God and those who publicly thank others is obvious. We are set apart for the things of God. God's people are not in the spotlight, nor do we seek it. Instead, we thank God silently throughout the day or audibly for others to hear, "I will praise you, O Lord, with all my heart; I will tell of all your wonders" (Ps 9:1).

Giving thanks to God is beyond the scope of earthly thanks and praise. We thank God in all circumstances—the good, the bad, and everything in between—not always easy, but it is God's will for us (1Thess. 5:18). Ultimately, when we give thanks to God, He receives all the glory. The spotlight is on Him as we gather around Word and Sacrament celebrating His greatest achievement—sending His Son Jesus Christ who bore our sin and became our Savior by rising again from the dead for our justification. This is the greatest reason to give thanks to God. I look forward to worshiping with you each time we come together at Immanuel to pray, praise, and give thanks to God. Amen.

Reason to Be Thankful


"Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; His love endures forever." So writes the psalmist in Psalm 107:1, and he goes on to list specific acts of God for which he gives thanks. David, in Psalm 103, writes, "Praise the Lord, O my soul; all my inmost being, praise His holy name...and forget not all His benefits..." and he, too, recounts the wonders of the Lord. It is a common occurrence in the psalms of David that, although he may express anguish and despair, he always ends his psalms on a note of confidence, for he knows his life is in God's almighty hands.

It's Thanksgiving time. Perhaps you're not feeling so thankful. We've been through a year and a half of the Covid pandemic and things just aren't right. Maybe you've been out of work. With the high price of gas, you are spending much more to drive your cars and to keep your homes warm. Maybe you've suffered the loss of someone you held dear. Maybe your health has deteriorated. Read what the prophet Habakkuk had to say about feelings and circumstances: "Though the fig tree does not bud and there are no grapes on the vines, though the olive crop fails and the fields produce no food, though there are no sheep in the pen and no cattle in the stalls, yet I will rejoice in the Lord, I will be joyful in God my Savior" (Habakkuk 3:17-18). If we received none of God's good gifts on this Earth, we have reason to rejoice in our Savior Who waits for us in Heaven! He is the source of our joy and the object of our gratitude. "The Lord has done great things for us, and we are filled with joy" (Psalm 126:3). Therefore, with hearts filled with thanksgiving, we can respond in words and acts of compassion and encouragement to those around us. We are blessed to be a blessing.


